The Holy Spirit - God's Gift

733 "God is Love"¹²⁴ and love is his first gift, containing all others. "God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us."¹²⁵

734 Because we are dead or at least wounded through sin, the first effect of the gift of love is the forgiveness of our sins. The communion of the Holy Spirit ¹²⁶ in the Church restores to the baptized the divine likeness lost through sin.

735 He, then, gives us the "pledge" or "first fruits" of our inheritance: the very life of the Holy Trinity, which is to love as "God [has] loved us."¹²⁷ This love (the "charity" of 1 Cor 13) is the source of the new life in Christ, made possible because we have received "power" from the Holy Spirit. ¹²⁸

736 By this power of the Spirit, God's children can bear much fruit. He who has grafted us onto the true vine will make us bear "the fruit of the Spirit: . . . love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control."¹²⁹ "We live by the Spirit"; the more we renounce ourselves, the more we "walk by the Spirit."¹³⁰

Through the Holy Spirit, we are restored to paradise, led back to the Kingdom of heaven, and adopted as children, given confidence to call God "Father" and to share in Christ's grace, called children of light and given a share in eternal glory. ¹³¹

Dear Sisters and Brothers:

Welcome to the 32nd NCRC Convention. I pray that each of you will be blessed with a renewal in the Baptism of the Holy Spirit. Our theme “He will Baptize You with the Holy Spirit and Fire” is John the Baptist’s proclamation to those who were coming to him to be baptized in the River Jordan for repentance. It was promised to all who would follow Jesus Christ. Since you have committed yourself to following Jesus Christ, you are to be Baptized with the Holy Spirit. What does that mean? What change does that bring to you? How are you to respond, to receive and to act? I pray that you understand and surrender to this blessing from God.

At the close of Vatican II, the Church spoke of the role of the laity in the document “Decree on the Apostolate of Lay People.” It was teaching that lay people have an apostolate, a ministry, a vocation uniquely theirs. The decree was published on November 18, 1965. In February, 1967, the Holy Spirit anointed a group of lay Catholics in the Ark and the Dove retreat center with the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. Fifteen months after the decree was released, the Holy Spirit acted in a “mighty current of grace.” A “mighty current of grace” is used by Pope Francis to describe the Baptism of the Holy Spirit and the gifts or charisms of the Holy Spirit. This Pentecost, the Catholic Charismatic Renewal International Service, also known as CHARIS, will be officially in the Dicastery for Laity, Family and Life. The Holy Spirit is moving in the Church to strengthen the laity to do greater works for God.

I have seen the numbers dwindle, but I believe that the vine has been trimmed and the fields are plowed. ***The vines have been trimmed of many who lived their lives in service to the Lord and have been taken to heaven. Fresh new branches will be growing and bearing much fruit.*** We are sowing the seeds of the Word into fields prepared to receive. It is the Holy Spirit that starts the growth and brings the bountiful harvest.

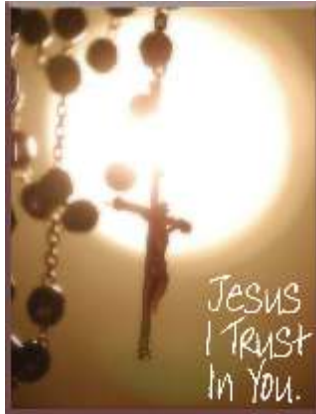

Bishop Mylo Vergara, D.D. Pasig Diocese - Philippines

Appointed by the St. John Paul II as third bishop of the Diocese of San Jose, Nueva Ecija, Philippines from 2005-2011 and is now the second bishop of the Diocese of Pasig. Bishop Mylo returns to NCRC to share his powerful ministry.



Rev. Dave Pivonka, Tor - Lorretto, PA

Father Dave Pivonka, is an evangelist who speaks at conferences, retreats and parish missions around the U.S. and throughout the world. For twenty years, he has also been leading pilgrimages around the world to some of the holiest and most important sites in our Christian faith. He spends much of his time helping others come to know God's love for them through his preaching, writings, CDs, and other spiritual outreaches. Fr. Dave is also responsible for *The Wild Goose Ministry* - a 14 part video series which explores what it is to have a relationship with the Holy Spirit and is currently the Director of Franciscan Pathways which is an evangelistic outreach of his Franciscan Community.



Rev. Levi Hartle - Pittsburg, PA

Fr. Levi Hartle was ordained in 2015 and is a priest of the Diocese of Pittsburg, which is the home of the *Ark and Dove* and the Catholic Charismatic Renewal! At the age of 18, God spoke clearly to him through one of the most profound prophetic words he had ever experienced, and from that day on he knew he would serve God as his priest! After being called to the priesthood, he went to college to study music so that he could use his musical gifts for the Lord as a priest. Directly after graduating from Grove City College with a degree in music education, he entered St. Paul Seminary in Pittsburgh. Father Levi has a spirit-filled gift of music which permeates hearts and souls as he leads people in praise & worship. He currently is Parochial Vicar for Holy Apostles Parish in Pittsburg, PA.



Deacon Steve Greco Irvine, CA

Deacon Steve Greco was called into the Charismatic Renewal in 1978 and has led a number of prayer groups for 35 years. He was ordained in 2007 in the Diocese of Orange. Rose Payán, PhD - Redwood City, CA

Rose is a gifted praise and worship leader and bible teacher whose desire is to lead many into a deeper intimacy with Jesus Christ. She has been active in the renewal for over 39 years and has been a speaker at many Life in the Spirit Seminars, charismatic workshops and a previous speaker at NCRC. 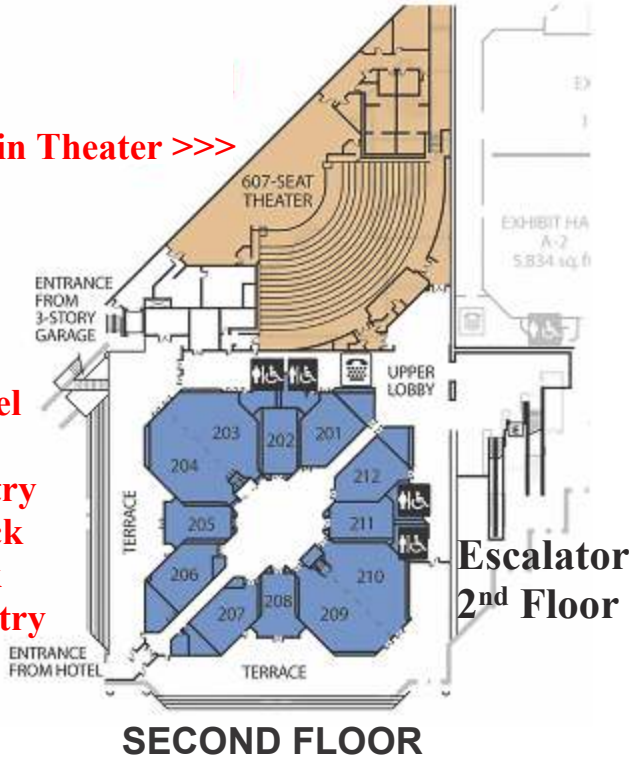

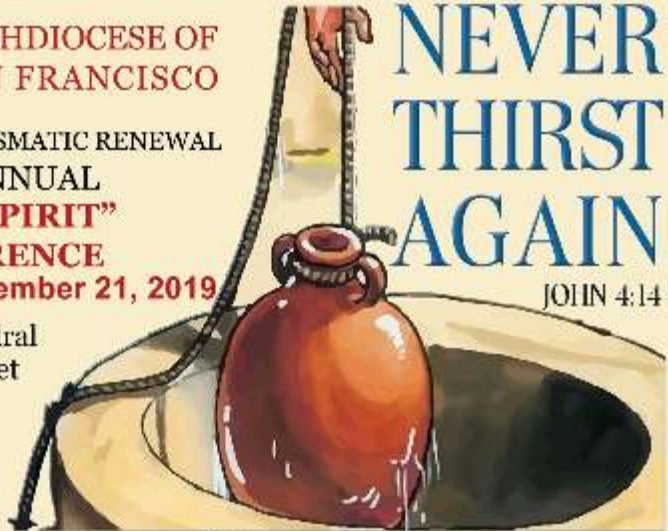
